


## Adding Item Comparables



The HTML content editor will open with a pre-defined comparables template ready for data to be entered. The template can be configured any way you like to fit your style for comparables data such as the text/table content, number of comps and layout. Just contact us if you want content that is different from the default.



If more comparables than what appear in the template are needed for the item, just click at the end of the existing content and then add additional templates from the “Insert -> Templates” menu.



After selecting the Item Comparables template, make sure the 'After "Target"' option is selected and then click OK to add the next comp stub.

Fill in your comparables content, save and then close the tab to return to the Worksheet.

Once back in the worksheet, the Render Properties dialog is displayed, allowing you to choose where the comparables content appears within the report. Most subscribers want the content with the item so the appropriate choice is “Render in Data Field”.
